

CHECK OUT REQUIREMENTS

In order to rent an aircraft in Aerowood's fleet, you must be a certificated pilot. Obtaining a check out is based on a gauge of the pilot's abilities, and is up to instructor discretion — we do not require a set number of hours for a check out; however, some of our aircraft do require a minimum number of hours in type or time (such as Complex time). Listed below are the minimum requirements to get checked out in each of our aircraft and fly it without an instructor.

Private Pilot Certificate or higher **AND** a tailwheel endorsement

Cessna 150

Private Pilot Certificate or higher

Cessna 172

Private Pilot Certificate or higher

Beechcraft Bonanza

Private Pilot Certificate or higher

High Performance endorsement

Complex endorsement **AND** 10 hours of Complex time

Cirrus SR20

Private Pilot Certificate or higher

Instrument Rating

10 hours in type
